

# Canada's Telecommunications Hall of Fame Nominations Form for 2006 Induction Ceremonies

## **Nomination Instructions**

Canada's Telecommunications Hall of Fame is proud to solicit nominations for its Laureate Program throughout the year from individuals, businesses, organizations and others. Nominees will be carefully evaluated by the Hall of Fame's Nominations Committee and Selection Committee and inducted into the Hall of Fame as Laureates if deemed to have made a lasting and important contribution to the Canadian telecommunications industry, and if all other selection criteria established by the Hall of Fame relevant to the nominee are satisfied (see paragraph 3 below).

To submit nominations for Canada's Telecommunications Hall of Fame please follow these instructions:

2. To assist the Nominations Committee in its research, the nominator should, where possible, attach information regarding the life and achievements of the nominee. Canada's Telecommunications Hall of Fame will accept resumés, biographies, articles, photographs, books and any other information in any media about the nominee but cannot guarantee that the material will be returned. Please do not send original documents.
3. Canada's Telecommunications Hall of Fame will accept all nominations but will only induct nominees who fulfill certain selection criteria. Generally, Laureates will be those individuals whose professional contributions have helped (i) to shape the Canadian, and in many cases the global telecommunications sector or (ii) to enhance the use and benefits of telecommunications for Canadians. Laureates need not be Canadian citizens, however, their contributions to Canadian telecommunications should be recognised as either having taken place in Canada or been conceived in Canada. 4. The Hall of Fame regrets that all worthy nominees will not be inducted in the year of their nomination. Due to the long and illustrious history of Canada's telecommunications sector, there are more deserving candidates than the Hall of Fame can reasonably induct at this early stage! Even though your nominee may satisfy all relevant selection criteria it may take several years after the nomination before your nominee will be inducted as a Laureate. All nominations submitted to Canada's Telecommunications Hall of Fame that satisfy all relevant selection criteria shall be eligible for induction during the year in question and for four consecutive years thereafter. If the nominee has not been inducted after the five year eligibility period, he or she may be eligible thereafter only at the discretion of the Nominations Committee.
